Arrangements for his wake and funeral are as follows:



A BEAUTIFUL Easter Hallelujah by two Canadian girls Cassandra and Callahan

Last year, a YouTube video was posted of sisters, Cassandra Star and Callahan Armstrong, singing a version of singer/songwriter Leonard Cohen's "Hallelujah" that alters many verses to tell about Jesus' death and resurrection. Kelley Mooney, the author of this Easter Hallelujah, wrote these beautiful verses when her church asked her to sing Leonard Cohen's song for the congregation on a Sunday.

In preparing to sing, Mooney, reviewed the lyrics and noticed that Leonard Cohen's version didn't tell the story of Easter; so she created new lyrics that she felt would not only tell what Jesus did through His sacrifice on Good Friday, but glorify His name and power that He showed when He was resurrected on Sunday.
