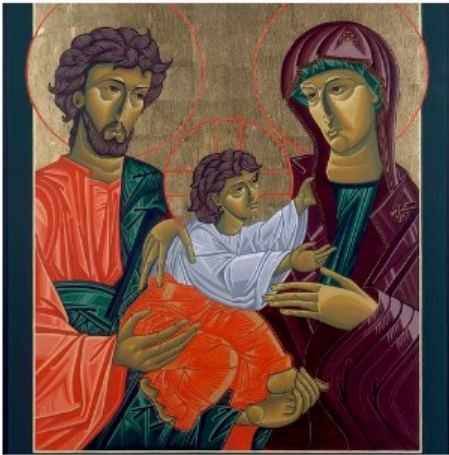

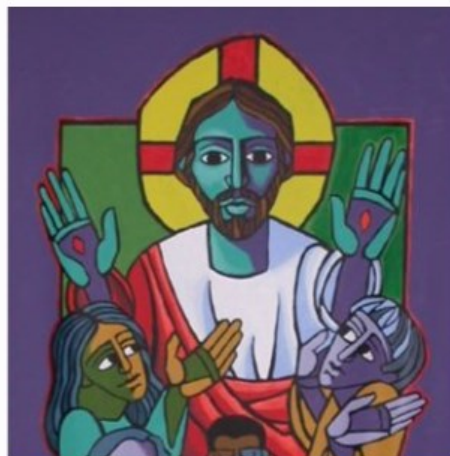

Fr. Paul Vaeth: Currently at LIJ Hospital in New Hyde Park NY. He will be admitted to treat a suspected UTI as well as address his general physical deterioration due to the disease progression of his Alzheimer's. At this point Fr. Paul's is struggling much more with the significant advancement of Alzheimer's. He is generally confused and finds it difficult to recognize who others are when he is interacting with Community members and staff. While treating the UTI, the medical team will also work with Fr. Paul's regular community neurologist and PCP in determining the extent of the progression of Alzheimer's and the recommended steps for ensuring Fr. Paul's safety in light of the vulnerability created by his confusion and related anxiety.

Fr. Lucian Clark: Currently in prep at LIJ in New Hyde Park NY for rescheduled surgery to remove a cancerous mass in his lower left leg. Will likely remain in hospital for 2-3 days post-surgery. Potential for short-term physical rehabilitation stay depending on post-surgical evaluation.

Fr. Javier Montalvo: He continues at Cliffside Rehab Facility in Flushing NY. His physical therapy treatment has stopped due to limited improvement in his capacity to ambulate without the support of a walker and staff accompaniment. He continues to require some medical treatment that cannot currently be administered at home. He is also undergoing further neurological testing to help determine why his ambulation is so limited.

Fr. Fran Landry: Recently returned from hospital due to a fall from his wheelchair. He had only a laceration on his head with no further injury. Fr. Fran's overall health has improved and he is managing well in Community.

Fr. John McMillan: He is generally in overall good health but experiencing some emotional struggle with his need to slow down due to occasional weakness and increased frailty in light of his advanced age.






Fr. Vincent Boney: transferred yesterday from St. Ann's in Scranton to Immaculate Conception in Jamaica, NY. He is medically stable and settling well into the new home environment. Prayers and the supportive presence and outreach of Community members is very beneficial as Fr. responds in a new setting to the challenges of advanced age and related frailty.

Br. Joe Rogers: Transferred back home to St. Ann's in Scranton from Allied Rehab Facility. Medically stable and currently requiring use of a walker for ambulation. Receiving a short-term period of intermittent in-home nursing oversight, physical/occupational therapy and possible caregiver assistance.

Fr. Richard Award: Has settled well into Immaculate Conception and has fully recovered from his previous deteriorated physical health condition while in Kingston, Jamaica WI. Actively participating in Community life in Jamaica NY. Using a walker to ensure safe ambulation. Planning an upcoming trip in September to Kingston with the Provincial and First Consultor to celebrate Fr. Richard's many years of service in ministry at St. Elizabeth Parish, School, and the Archdiocese of Kingston.
